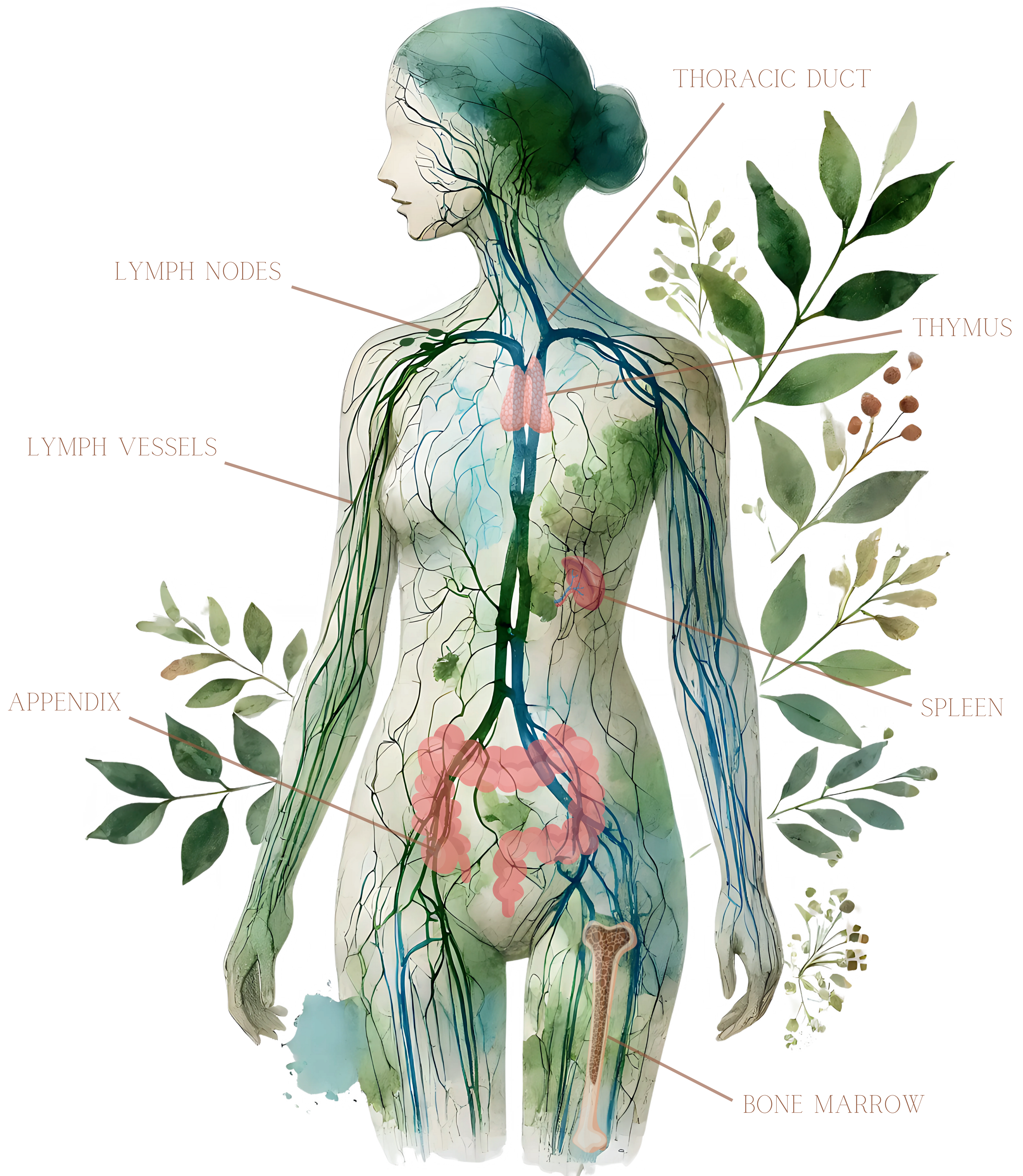


LYMPHATIC SYSTEM



1. Cervical Lymph Nodes are located in the neck and filter lymph from the head and neck.
2. Axillary Lymph Nodes are found in the armpits, draining lymph from the arms, chest, and upper abdomen.
3. Inguinal Lymph Nodes are located in the groin and filter lymph from the lower limbs, lower abdomen, and genitalia.
4. Mediastinal Lymph Nodes are found in the chest area, draining lymph from the lungs and trachea.
5. Mesenteric Lymph Nodes are located in the abdomen and filter lymph from the intestines.
6. Popliteal Lymph Nodes are behind the knee, draining lymph from the lower leg and foot.
